## How can I promote the longlist to my pupils?

- Create a display showing the longlisted books.
- Download and print the bookmarks to hand out to pupils, perhaps put them in all books you lend out (regardless of whether they are on the award this year or not!)
- Book clubs and classes are a great way to tell pupils about the award.

## How do pupils vote for the shortlist?

- Pupils can vote via the BBA website using the online poll.
- You can collate the votes on the bookmarks and email them to us.
